#129379 - Spiral Flower Originals Die # 132994 - 1 package of Watercolor Wonder Designer Series Paper #120999 - Very Vanilla 1/2" Seam Binding Ribbon 4 x 9 Styrofoam Tree Cone Sewing or Floral Pins Quilling Tool or Skewer to wrap flowers Hot Glue



start with a 4" x 9" styrofoam tree



cut approximately 72 flowers from the SPIRAL FLOWER DIE, roll and hot glue approximately 72 flowers - you will need 9 sheets of Designer Series Paper (the # will depend on how tight or loose you roll them).



start hot gluing them to the styrofoam tree.



This is what it should look like when you have them all adhered to the styrofoam tree - $\,$ BUT we are not done yet!
