- 2. Starburst Bundle #134817 wood or #134818 clear mount (remember, by purchasing "Bundles" you save 15% of each piece when you buy a "bundle")
- 3. Perfect Blend #130745 wood or #131392 clear mount

### Directions:

- 1. Cut out the base and score at 1 1/2", 2 1/2", 4 1/2", 6 1/2", 8 1/2", 9 1/2". Fold the top pieces on each side "out" and fold the rest of the folds "in".
- 2. Put together the top pieces (put the fancy edges into the slits) and punch an oval with the Large Oval Punch through both pieces at the same time.
- 3. To make the box, cut a piece of card stock  $8" \times 53/4"$ . Score the short side at 17/8" and 37/8". Then rotate and score the long edge at 17/8" and 61/8"
- 4. With the long end on top (short ends on the side), cut up on the two score marks; rotate 180 degrees and cut those two. Now going from the outside in, cut out the triangle.



- 5. Add your adhesive to the remaining triangle and glue your box together (you will put the adhesive on the outside of the triangle and the triangle will get adhered to the inside of the box.
- 6. Adhere your box to the middle of your Pop 'n Cut's piece. Decorate for your event or gift.
