TWIST AND POP UP CARD With Deb Valder www.stampladee.com



This fun interactive card is sooooooo easy to make. Let's do it step by step.

SUPPLIES

Stamp Set: BD-0036 Snow Buddy Bundle; SS-0181 Striped Love

Card Stock: CS-0082 Denim Days; CS-0094 River Stone; CS-0040 Whisper White

Ink: IP-0010 Denim Days; IP-0009 Black Licorice

Accessories: TO-0039 Journey Blooms Paper Trimmer; JM-0078 Journey Color Splash Watercolor Pencils; TO-0064

Grand Pro Shears:

TO-0040 Crease Tool; AD-0081 Easy Glide; AD-0001 White Liner Tape; AD-0085 Medium Foam Squares; AD-0111 Journey Craft Glue; TO-0073 Bloom Tool; AC-0116 Journey Sequins HOLIDAY Elements

PREP...

- 1. Base Card 4 ¼" x 11" and scored at 5 ½"
- 2. Outside of the Card
 - a. 3 ¾" x 5" Whip Cream
 - b. 3" x 4" Denim Days
 - c. 2 1/2" x 3 1/3" River Stone
 - d. Scrap of Whip Cream big enough to stamp Snow Buddy
- 3. Inside of the Card
 - a. Pop Up BASE 10 %" x 8 %"; Score on the 10 %" side at 5 3/8" Turn so the 8 %" side is on top and score at 2 %"; 4 %"; 6 %"
 - b. Two layer pieces (3 ¾" x 5")
 - c. Pop Up PANEL 2 ¾" x 11"; Score at 2 ¾"; 5 ½"; 8 ¼" accordion fold this with the middle crease UP!
 - d. Cut 4 of the bottom layer (bottom piece River Stone) 2 ½" x 2 ½"
 - e. Cut 4 of the top layer (top piece Whip Cream) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Construction...FRONT

- 1. On the 3 ¾" x 5" Whip Cream layer, stamp Snow Buddy and cut him out with the matching metal die
- 2. Stamp the Whip Cream piece (the one you cut out Snow Buddy) with the smallest snowflake and adhere with Easy Glide
- 3. Adhere the Denim Days layer with Medium Foam Squares
- 4. Adhere the River Stone layer with Easy Glide
- 5. Stamp, color and adhere Snow Buddy with Medium Journey Foam Squares
- 6. Using our Journey Craft Glue, adhere the Holiday Sequins




Construction...INSIDE


- 1. The two $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" pieces need to be cut down and stamped.
 - a. Measure down 1 ¾" on the left and put a pencil mark and repeat for the right side
 - b. Measure over to the 1 7/8" mark and put a pencil mark
 - c. Using a ruler, connect both of these marks and cut so you have two finished pieces that look like a house. MAKE A TEMPLATE AND SAVE!



- 2. Using the 10 ¾" x 8 ½" BASE card, fold in half and with the fold on the left (53/8" side on top)
- 3. Put the fold on the 1" mark and make a pencil mark on top and bottom
- 4. Move the piece over to the 1 ¼" and make a pencil mark on the 2 ¼" and 6 ¼" part (it's where the score line is)
- 5. Connect the tick marks stopping at the score line.
- 6. Cut out the bottom left ad bottom right so you have a "T" shape left (fold on top)



7. Fold the lower left corner up and line up the center creases...see picture...




The two center creases line up!

8. Now do the same for the right side



Line up centers


9. Now the middle should just pop to the inside (very easy because you used your crease tool for nice lines!



10. Add the two "house" pieces



11. Time to add this piece to the card base. Make sure you put White Liner Tape all over both sides (only take the tape off on one side at a time. When you are adding this piece, line up the bottom of the "house" so it has a nice even border all around the base card. If the point of the "house" does not line up perfectly, not to worry, it won't show, concentrate more on the bottom border.




12. Stamp all four pieces and layer them up on the 2 ¾" x 11" strip. I popped the snowflakes with Foam Squares.



13. Now you will add a piece of White Liner Tape to the lower left corner and the upper right corner.



14. Fold up the strip so the openings are at the BOTTOM and lay it on the inside bottom of the base card. Simply close the top of the card down onto the folded piece (so it doesn't open upside down, the top square should be the one that is on the left when open – reading from left to right).



15. Turn the card and repeat to the other side and it will be adhered to the card base.



16. And now when you open it...wahhhhh lahhhhh it's DONE!



17. Wasn't that soooooooo easy! Make them and send me your version!
