Stamps: Storybook Occasions; Make a Wish Bundle;
Summer Rose; Greeting Bouquet (for the Rose Card)

Paper: 12 x 12 Whip Cream; Limeade Splash; Banana Cream; Spring Filled Prints; Romantic Journey

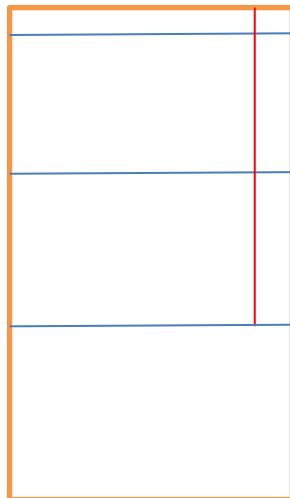
Ink: Black Licorice; Limeade Splash

Accessories: Whip Cream Thread; Lemongrass Thread; Fashion Silver Pearls; Party Burst Dots;
Journey Blooms Trimmer; Details Pro Shears; Crease Tool; Confectionary Days PanPastels; Journey
Color Splash Watercolor Pencils; Journey Craft Glue; White Liner Tape; Small and Medium Foam
Squares; Easy Glide Adhesive; The Amaze Die Cutting Machine; Tattered Bloom Minis Die; Cloud
Dreams Die Bundle; Birthday Bash Embossing Folder; Above the Clouds Embossing Folder; Layered

Cutting:

Base – starting with a piece of 12 x 12 Whisper White

1. $5\frac{1}{2}''$ x $11\frac{1}{2}''$ and score at $\frac{1}{4}''$; $3\frac{3}{4}''$; $7\frac{1}{4}''$
2. $2\frac{3}{4}''$ x $4\frac{1}{4}''$ (extra Panel)
3. Front Panel Layers:
 - a. (1) limeade splash $2\frac{1}{2}''$ X 4
 - b. (1) Whip Cream $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x $3\frac{3}{4}''$
4. Inside 1st Panel Layers:
 - a. (1) limeade splash $2\frac{1}{2}''$ X 4
 - b. (1) Banana Cream $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x $3\frac{3}{4}''$
5. Inside 2nd Panel Layers:
 - a. (1) Limeade Splash $3\frac{1}{4}''$ x $4\frac{5}{8}''$
 - b. (1) Whip Cream $3''$ x $4\frac{3}{8}''$
 - c. (1) Printed Paper $2''$ x $2\frac{3}{8}''$
 - d. (1) $\frac{1}{4}''$ x $3\frac{1}{4}''$ strip of Limeade Splash
6. Inside 3rd Panel Layers:
 - a. (1) Limeade Splash $3\frac{1}{4}''$ x $4\frac{5}{8}''$
 - b. (1) Banana Cream $3''$ x $4\frac{3}{8}''$
 - c.
7. 4th Panel
 - a. (1) Limeade Splash $4''$ x $5\frac{1}{4}''$
 - b. (1) Whip Cream $3\frac{3}{4}''$ x $5''$
 - c. (1) Limeade Splash $2\frac{3}{8}''$ x $3\frac{1}{2}''$
 - d. (1) Printed Paper $2\frac{3}{8}''$ x $3\frac{1}{2}''$
8. Turn the long piece of cardstock so the $\frac{1}{4}''$ score is at the top and CUT at the $\frac{5}{8}''$ mark down to the last score mark. You will not go into the last panel.



9. Accordion fold the panels so the small $\frac{1}{4}$ " strip is on top and the large base is the last panel.
10. Adhere the front panel ($2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ") to the small tab (cut away that little piece on top that sticks out)
11. This will now make your entire card.
12. Decorate and embellish as you like.
