

Creating a Snow Globe Box

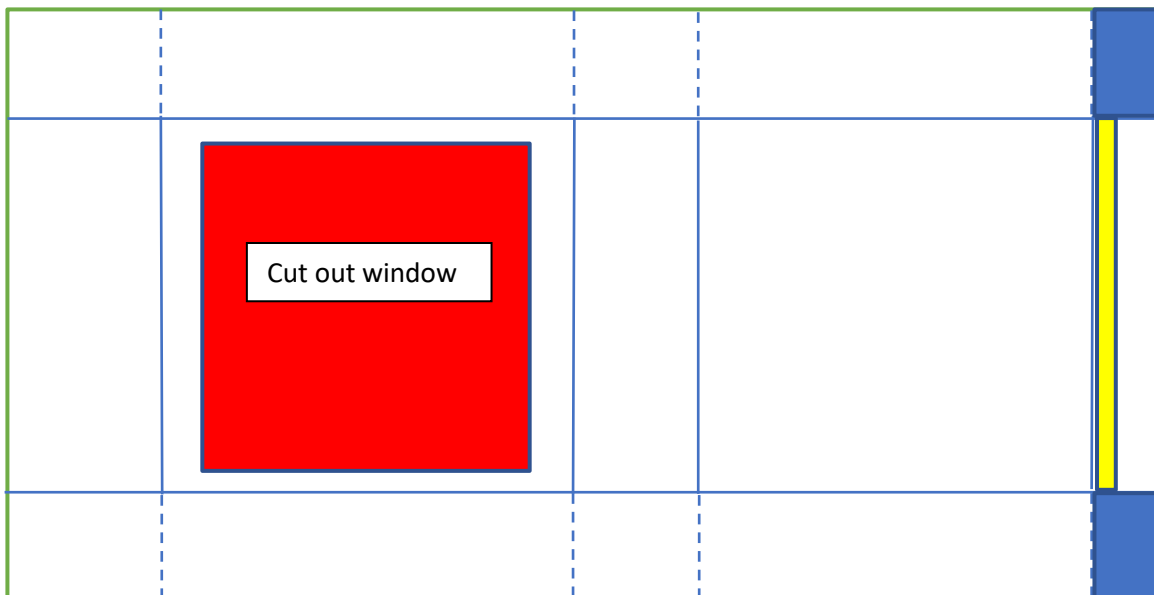

1. Cut the box 8" x 10.5"
2. Score as follows:
 - a. On the long side at 1.5"; 5"; 6.5" and 10"
 - b. On the short side at 1.5" turn and again on the short side at 1.5"
3. Cut on the dotted lines (see diagram below)
4. Cut OUT the two dark blue sections and add $\frac{1}{4}$ " tape (the yellow line below)



5. Using the Stitched Nesting Rectangles, cut out the window. If you don't have a wide die cut machine, use these pictures to guide you through the cutting.



6. Bevel the short tabs as shown in the picture below.



7. Now working on the INSIDE of the snow globe, add 1/8" double sided tape around window then place the 3 3/8" x 4 5/8" acetate piece to the opening.



8. Next you'll add the rest of the tape to the inside of the box as pictured below.



9. It's time to assemble.

- a. Start with the side seam (the little $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam).
- b. Then with the window facing you and working on the bottom, fold the front flap in; next will be the two little side flaps then the back flap will be adhered.
- c. Fill the inside of the snow globe with anything you are working on. I love doing these for different occasions.
- d. Repeat the upper flap just as you did for the bottom flap with one addition... Poke a hole through the top flaps and add your star that is on a string.

10. Add your ribbon around the entire box. I tied it into a bow and you are done!

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
