

## SLIMLINE POP & FLIP Card

With Teaspoon of Fun

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### **Slimline Version POP & FLIP card:**

Cut:

Slimline Card Base 7" by 8 ½" scored at 3 ½"

(1) 3 ½" x 8 ½" white layer

(1) 3 ½" x 8 ½" designer paper

(3) 1 ¼" x 2" scored at ½" and 1" and 1 ½"

(3) 1" x 1 ¾" scored at 1"

(1) 3 ¼" x 8 ¼" inside layer

Directions:

1. Use one of our slimline base cards
2. Cut the front of the card leaving a 1" border all the way around.



3. Take a piece of Designer Paper and a piece of the same color as your card base and cut it 3 ½" x 8 ½".
4. Take your Decorative Rectangle Aperture Trio Die and cut through BOTH pieces at the same time. It's important to have them identical. I put the "right" sides together before I cut them out. Make sure you watch the video to see why!
5. Put a little "tic" mark on the top of the patterned paper and a little "tic" mark on the colored card stock so you know which is the top of the card for each piece.
6. Take your ¼" and your 1/8" Tear Tape and add it to the back of your designer paper. Adhere this to the TOP OUTSIDE of your card base over the hole.
7. Take your ¼" and your 1/8" Tear Tape and add it to the back of your colored card stock piece. Adhere this to the TOP INSIDE of your card base over the hole.
8. Take the three pieces you cut out and adhere the designer paper and the cardstock together. Set aside.

9. If you are going to stamp on the inside of your card, do that now before you put it together.
10. Adhere this to the inside of your card base.
11. Grab your three  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" pieces and fold going in the same direction (it forms a square cylinder).
12. On the outside bottom of the first panel, use your  $\frac{1}{4}$  Tear Tape and put two rows of tape to secure it. Center it in the window and secure on the inside bottom panel.
13. Now fold in half and put one piece of tear tape on the cut edge (not the folded edge), by not putting two pieces on, this gives it little wiggle power.
14. Complete the other two exactly like you did above.
15. Now we need to put the tabs on. They are uneven tabs so don't worry that you scored them wrong!
16. Working on the longest panel first, fold in half and put a piece of adhesive on the end. Adhere that to the center of the "square cylinder".
17. With this piece folded in half, put a piece of tape on the end.
18. Now you are ready to add the cut squares that we set aside above. Watch the video to show you the easiest way to do that for perfect alignment.
19. Embellish and you are done! Give it a try.

If you are intimidated by the three windows, start with one window (measurements below).

**SINGLE WINDOW POP & FLIP Card:**

Card base that measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and scored at  $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

Cut one piece at 3" x 4" scored at 1", 2" and 3"

Cut one piece at  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " and scored at  $1\frac{1}{4}$ "
